1. Issuer's name: Monroe Electronics

& Object of the declaration:

All products manufactured and distributed by Monroe Electronics.

'. The object of the declaration described above is to ensure conformity of products with the requirements of the following documents:

RoHS is the acronym for Restriction of Hazardous Substances. RoHS, also known as Directive 2002/95/EC, originated in the European Union and restricts the use of six hazardous materials found in electrical and electronic products.

WEEE is the acronym for Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment. WEEE, also known as Directive 2002/96/EC, mandates the treatment, recovery and recycling of electric and electronic equipment (over 90% ends up in landfills), and also originated in the EU.

4. Additional Information

The European Union's RoHS Directive (2002/95/EC) goes into effect on July 1, 2006. The products covered under this directive are split into categories using those developed under the WEEE Directive (2002/96/EC). All of the instrumentation manufactured by Monroe Electronics falls under Category 9, Measurement and Control Equipment. Currently this category is exempt from RoHS compliance until at least 2010, when it and other exemptions will be reviewed.
